Rules:

- Garbage must be sorted into the following categories below.
- Garbage must be put into the city-designated garbage bags or transparent/semitransparent bags.
- Garbage must be left at the designated garbage collection site from 6:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m.

* Do not put garbage or recyclables out in cardboard boxes. (Cardboard boxes must be put out at a garbage collection site only on the paper collection day.)

Garbage collection sites are managed by neighborhood associations which provide funding and staff. Let's keep the stations clean!!

Category	How to Separate and Dispose of Recyclables	How to put out garbage for collection
Garbage	Combustible garbage <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ●Plastic: Containers of yogurt, cooking oil, polystyrene foam, etc. ●Plastic bag: Plastic shopping bag, plastic wrapping material, etc. ●Non-recyclable paper: Wastepaper, carbon paper, plastic/vinyl coated paper, etc. ●Rubber and leather product: Rubber glove, rubber hose, etc. ●Others: Blanket(futon), mattress (no spring), carpet, aluminum foil, fallen leaves, grass, tent (no frame), disposable pocket warmer, etc. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★Items that do not fit in a 45 liter Misawa City designated garbage bag or a 45 liter transparent/semi-transparent bag must be disposed of as bulky garbage. ★Items that do not fit in bags, such as futons, mattresses (no springs), and carpets must be folded into the smallest shape possible, and tied crosswise. ★Use up the entire contents of lighters or other inflammable items because they may cause fire in garbage trucks. ★Bamboo and tree branches less than 2 cm in diameter must be cut into pieces with a maximum length of 60 cm, and must be bundled together. (Bamboo and tree branches with a diameter 2 cm or greater must be cut into pieces with a maximum length of 60 cm, and must be brought to the Incineration Plant in Misawa City. Do not leave at the garbage collection site for pickup.) ★Drain food scraps thoroughly. ★Cooking oil must be absorbed with pieces of paper, or solidified with an agent. ★Dangerous items such as bamboo skewers must be wrapped in thick paper.
	Non-combustible garbage <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ●Metal item: Glass jar/bottle cap, square steel can, etc. ●Small electric appliances: Microwave oven, toaster oven, blender, iron, printer, VCR, etc. ●Glass item: Cosmetic jar, light bulb, fluorescent light, etc. ●Ceramic: Tea cup, plate, etc. ●Others: Ski boot, modelling clay/dough, tent frame, water tank, etc. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★Items that do not fit in a 45 liter Misawa City designated garbage bag or a 45 liter transparent/semi-transparent bag must be disposed of as bulky garbage.
	Bulky garbage <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ●Furniture: Kotatsu (Japanese heater table), table, bed, etc. ●Others: Umbrella, shovel, laundry pole, golf club, electric blanket, electric carpet, large speaker 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★Remove kerosene oil and batteries from oil heaters. ★Sharp edges such as broken glasses and knives must be wrapped in a piece of thick paper or a rag and write "DANGER" on it. ★Dry-cell batteries, fluorescent tubes and mercury thermometers must be disposed separately in other garbage bags.
Recyclables	Paper <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Newspaper, Weekly magazine, monthly magazine, catalog, miscellaneous recyclable paper (confectionery box, box and winding core of plastic wrap, etc.) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★Wash, open and dry paper cartons for beverage and tie with string. ★Put paper and fabric items in a transparent/semi-transparent bag in wet weather.
	Fabric <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ●100% cotton clothing, towel, bed sheet, undershirt, etc. (Dispose of small items such as sock and glove as combustible garbage) 	
	Glass bottle <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Remove the lid and rinse the inside of the bottle with water. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★Remove the lid and rinse the inside of the bottle with water. ★Put bottles in a transparent/semi-transparent bag. No need to separate them based on their color. ★Cosmetic jars must be disposed of as non-combustible garbage.
	Can <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ●Aerosol spray can and gas can cartridge: Use up the entire contents before disposing. Remove any dirt and debris from the can. Rinse the inside with water. ●Aluminum can and steel can: Products labelled with the aluminum mark. Products labelled with the steel mark. ●Canned food can, aluminum or steel food container: Food can 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★Only beverage and food can be collected. ★Rinse the inside of the can with water. ★Aerosol spray cans and gas can cartridges may cause fire in garbage trucks. Use up the gas and put cans or cartridges in a transparent/semi-transparent bag for pickup.
Plastic bottle <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ●Water/tea container: Put out only items marked with the PET symbol. Remove the bottle cap. Dispose of the cap as combustible garbage. ●Juice/liquor/condiment container: Rinse the inside with water. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★Remove the lid and rinse with water (Dispose of plastic bottles for cooking oil as combustible garbage.)
