Rules/Warnings


- 1. Owners must enter the park with their dogs. Please keep an eye on your dog at all times and be able restrain them if necessary.
- 2. Children of middle school age and below must have a guardian with them. (Children 5 and under not allowed)
- 3. No eating, drinking, or smoking inside the dog park
- 4. No brushing or shampooing your dog in the park.
- 5. Collect your dog's poop and bring it home for disposal. Please try to have your dog pee by the "toilet marker" post.
- 6. To avoid fighting among dogs, please wait until your dog is safe and comfortable in the park before taking off its leash. Be sure to put the leash back on when exiting the park.
- 7. Dog treats and toys are allowed but please avoid using them when other dogs are present.
- 8. Trouble caused in the park should be resolved by those involved. Park management bears no responsibility for any accidents or injuries that occur. Enter at your own risk.

↓The following dogs are not ↓ allowed

- 1. Dogs that have not taken the rabies vaccine or a combination vaccine. (Both vaccines are required)
- 2. Dogs with contagious diseases.
- 3. Dogs in heat.
- 4. "Fighting" dogs (dogs bred for fighting, such as the Tosa Inu).
- 5. Dogs that continuously bark and become aggressive in the presence of other dogs.
- 6. Dogs that cannot obey their owner's commands.
